SUBJECT:	Consideration and possible approval of a resolution to declare district property as surplus property for the purpose of soliciting bids for sale.
BACKGROUND:	This is in reference to an approximate 2.5-acre tract of land out of and a part of the Restricted Reserve called 9.74 acres described in the deed to Pasadena ISD and located at the southeast corner of 206 N. Perez St. South Houston TX, (old L.F. Smith site).
	The approximate 2.5 acre tract represents surplus property that will not be needed for district related purposes.
	In order to solicit bids, the board of trustees must declare the parcel as surplus property under Texas Education Code and comply with Section 272.001 of the Texas Local Government Code which sets forth procedures for solicitation of bids for the sale of the property.
FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:	There will be minimal costs associated with the advertising of the solicitation of bids. If sold, the funds will bolster the district's fund balance.
RECOMMENDATION:	We recommend approval of a resolution to declare district property as surplus property for the purpose of soliciting bids for sale.
