Re: Bid Results for Pickup Trucks

Attached please find a recommendation from Harry Lau, Administrator of Operations for the purchase of three pickup trucks. The source of funds for this purchase is the Capital Projects fund (funds received from the sale of property in 2013). We discussed the use of these funds for a one-time purchase of vehicles and reserving approximately \$60,000 of the funds for textbooks in 2014/2015.

These three trucks will replace the vehicles currently in use in the maintenance department. The maintenance trucks will be evaluated and repurposed to the High Schools and any vehicles at the high schools still working will be reused or sold at auction. We currently have 13 pickup trucks that vary in age from five to 19 years old.

We are recommending the low bidder, Signature Ford for a total cost of \$81,000; just over our original estimate of \$80,000 and within our budget. The bid tabulation is attached for your reference.
