#### RESOLUTION

# HONORABLE DISMISSAL OF TEACHERS ON CONTRACTUAL CONTINUED SERVICE

WHEREAS, the teachers hereinafter set forth are TENURED teachers employed during the 2010-2011 school term; and

WHEREAS, The Board has first removed or dismissed all teachers who have not entered upon contractual continued service before removing or dismissing any teacher named herein who is legally qualified to hold a position currently held by a teacher who has not entered upon contractual continued service; and

WHEREAS, as between teachers who have entered upon contractual continued service, the teachers with the shorter length of continuing service with the School District shall be dismissed first, unless an alternative method of determining the sequence of dismissal is established in a collective bargaining agreement between the Board and any exclusive bargaining representative; and

WHEREAS, an alternative method of determining the sequence of dismissal is not established in an applicable collective bargaining agreement, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on the question of the dismissals in not required; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education has determined that the teachers on contractual continued service named herein shall be honorably dismissed at the end of the 2010-2011 school term, pursuant to Section 24-11 of <u>The School Code of Illinois</u> (105 ILCS 5/24/-11).

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Board of Education of Oak Park School District 97, Cook County, Illinois, that:

<u>Section 1:</u> The following named tenured teachers shall be honorably dismissed at the end of the 2010-2011 school term because of the decision of the Board to discontinue some particular type of teaching service(s):

Todd Leban Kristiana Murray Jennifer Raia Kristen Sundquist

<u>Section 2:</u> The President and Secretary of the Board are authorized and directed to give the teachers a written Notice and Statement of Reduction in Force and Non-Reemployment by certified mail, return receipt requested, at least sixty (60) days before the end of the school term. A copy of said Notice is attached as Exhibit "A" and incorporated by reference.

<u>Section 3:</u> The Superintendent or designee shall also personally deliver a copy of said Notice to the teacher with a signature receipt. A copy of said receipt is attached as Exhibit "B" and incorporated by reference.

Section 4: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its passage.
