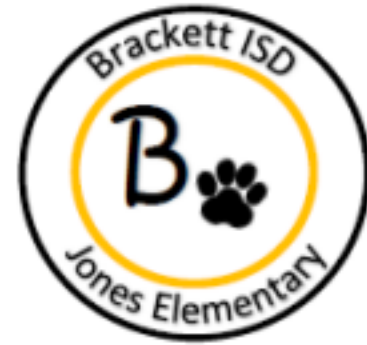

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Principal's General Narrative:

As I look back on the school year my initial thought is how fast the year flew by. I can honestly say that this year has been the most enjoyable principal job I have had. The students were very respectful and well behaved. The students worked very hard and showed vast improvement in social skills and academically.

Our third grade students did not perform well on the STAAR tests. This is not to say that there was no student growth throughout the year. Many of the students came to third grade well below grade level. This was recognized and addressed early in the year. Growth was made but about half of the students are not where they should be. We are making plans to address this issue by hiring another 4th grade teacher to lower our class sizes.

Our 5th grade science scores were not good and mirrored the scores from last year. We had two teachers in 5th grade responsible for three STAAR tests. This was the same as last year. This coming year we have hired a teacher that will teach science and social studies.

Our teachers have worked very hard all year long and the students enjoyed school. When these two factors are in place positive things will happen.
