Goal/Objective Addressed	District Goal 1: College or Career Readiness Graduates of Crosby ISD will be prepared for success after high school by being adequately prepared for either college or work force success.
Background	Districts are required to certify annually to the State Board of Education and the Commissioner of Education that, for each subject in the required curriculum, students have access to instructional materials that cover all of the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills. Districts will be unable to submit any requisitions or engage funds provided by the State of Texas for purchases until the certification has been signed and submitted to TEA. This action will allow State funding to provide instructional materials to Crosby ISD students.
