Recommendation:

EMERGENCY ITEM – The following agenda item is necessary to due to an emergency or urgent public necessity that requires immediate action of the Board or an imminent threat to public health and safety or a reasonably unforeseeable situation, as follows:

Discussion and Possible Action to Approve Remote Conferencing Waivers with Texas Education Agency.

The above item is necessary due to the necessity to immediately address COVID-19 related measures and budgetary expenditures, which are necessary for the health and well-being of UISD students.

Rationale:

Remote Conferencing is a new process to provide eligible students with a minimum of 20 school days in remote instruction. If any eligible student requires more than the 20 days approved by the Texas Education agency, United ISD must submit a waiver requesting an extension to the initial 20 days.

Budgetary Information:

Remote Conferencing as approved by the TEA, allows United ISD to claim average daily attendance for eligible students and to extend the number of days if the waiver is submitted and approved by the Texas Education Agency.
