Subject: PA 48 Goals and Benchmark Goals

I would like to request to be placed on the Curriculum Committee agenda for the October 10, 2022, Board of Education Committee of the Whole meeting. I would like to share each of our schools' PA 48 goals for the 2022-23 school year. Below is a description of the requirements of the PA 48 law.

<u>Public Act 48 of 2021</u> section 98b requires districts, traditional public, public school academies, and intermediate districts who wish to receive state aid for 2022-2023 year to:

- Establish school goals expected to be achieved for the 2022-23 school year. These goals must:
 - Be established with the school leader and teachers by September 15, 2022
 - Correlate to goals established in the extended learning plans from 2021-2022
 - Contain achievement or growth goals that will be measured in reading and math for all grades
 - In grades K-8 the goal must be based on benchmark assessments that are approved under the Third Grade Reading Law
 - Presented, not later than the first board meeting in February 2023 and not later than the last board meeting of the academic year, on accomplishments of school established goals
 - Ensure that the information presented to the Board is disaggregated by grade level, by student demographics, and by the mode of instruction received by the pupils to whom the information applies
 - Post the information through the transparency reporting link located on the district's website

I look forward to sharing our results of these goals in January and in June.
