## C.L.A.I.M. - Finance Work Group DRAFT - May 12, 2016

**Focus/Beliefs:** Access to adequate educational funding is critical to the success of District 97's mission to guarantee that each student achieves optimal intellectual growth while developing socially, emotionally, and physically through a system distinguished by:

- Exemplary instruction focused on each student
- Commitment to the needs of a diverse population
- Meaningful partnerships with families and the community
- Celebrations of the power of art, music, and language
- Confident students challenged to be educational risk-takers

Diminution of funding resources applies significant pressure on the District to fulfill its mission without further compromise to student instruction in the future.

**Top Legislative Priorities to Monitor:** C.L.A.I.M. proposes monitoring the following issues in support of adequate educational funding:

- 1. School funding reforms at the State, and to a lesser extent County and Federal level.
- 2. Efforts at the State level to freeze local property taxes.
- 3. Efforts at the State level to shift pension costs from the State onto District 97.
- 4. The effect of funded and unfunded mandates on District finances.
- 5. Miscellaneous cost and revenue measures that potentially impact costs and revenue sources to District 97 such as local zoning compliance, new revenue sources, residency requirements, etc.

**Efforts to Achieve the Goal**: C.L.A.I.M. proposes the following to support the District in its efforts to monitor the District's revenue sources:

- Connect with the community to inform citizens and to hear concerns with public forums such as the annual Legislator Forum.
- Ongoing outreach and dialogue with our Federal, State and Local lawmakers.
- Participation and collaboration with outside groups, such as Ed-Red, to share concerns and support strategies for upcoming legislation.
- Ongoing outreach and dialogue with local support agencies serving similar constituencies – District 200, District 90, Collaboration for Early Childhood, Oak Park Township Youth Services, Oak Park Education Foundation, etc.
