What is MTSS?

MTSS (Multi-tiered System of Supports) is a proactive, preventative framework that integrates data and instruction to maximize student achievement, well-being, and engagement from a strengths-based perspective.

Key Features

- Three-Tiered Model
- Data-Driven Decision Making
- Collaborative Problem-Solving
- Whole-Child Focus

Why MTSS Matters

- Enables early identification and support
- Reduces unnecessary special education referrals through strong general education interventions.



MTSS: Attendance Supports

Current Supports

- Proactive attendance letters to our families
- Shared district resources for our families
- Clear communication process for staff

Work in Progress

- Follow-up calls, conferences, and targeted communication to our families
- Collaborative problem-solving with families
- Logging all interventions in Synergy

Next Steps

- Build attendance dashboards for real-time building data and weekly updates
- Strengthen family-school partnerships through structured collaboration

Current Supports


- Pyramid Model (Early Learning)
- MTSS Social Workers (Early Learning)
- Tier 1 SEL Screener (Early Learning-12)
- Tier 2 Behaviorists (K-5)
- Tier 3 Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA) consultation (Early Learning -12)

Work in Progress

- Reviewing SEL screener data in MTSS teams
- Meeting Monthly for the Behavior/Discipline Joint Committee
- Building consistency with Tier 1 instruction
- Implementing Tier 2 SEL small group instruction

Next steps

- Build shared understanding of Tier 1-3 roles and purposes
- Establish Tier 1-3 SEL/Behavioral Teams in every building





MTSS: Academic Supports

Current Supports

- Universal screeners and progress monitoring tools to identify learning gaps proactively
- Tiered academic interventions aligned to student needs

Work in Progress

- Implementing updated placement criteria so students are matched to the correct tier
- Improving processes for student placement
- Developing a resource guide linking interventions to specific skills gaps in literacy and numeracy
