## **Definition: Educational Specifications**



The Texas Education Agency requires all school districts to create and review a written educational program that guides the design process of new proposed facilities or major renovations.

Educational specifications provide the link between learning and the design of educational facilities. They outline essential educational concepts and detailed facility needs, current and future educational delivery, and the impact of technology on learning.

Educational specifications should support the overall educational goals of the district, yet be nimble enough to allow for the effective and efficient design of school facilities.

The educational specifications provide specific facility needs to complement the district's educational delivery model. These will also provide consistency among similar project types from campus to campus.

This document is a living document, in need of periodic update on a 5-year basis.


