RECOMMENDATIONS:

Staff recommends that the Board of Trustees approve Competitive Sealed Proposals (TX Education Code 44.039) as the method of procurement that provides the best value for Construction Projects and authorize the Superintendent or Designee to execute resulting contract.

RATIONALE:

As per Texas Education Code 44.035, the Board of Trustees of a school district that is considering a construction contract using a method specified by Section 44.031 must before advertising determine which method provides the best value. Competitive Sealed Proposals (CSP) is best suited for projects that are neither schedule sensitive nor subject to potential change. As such, the Administration recommends that the CSP method be determined by the School Board of Trustees as the project delivery/contract to be used for future construction projects, unless as otherwise approved by the Board of Trustees.
