United ISD Early College Programs

- Early College High Schools (ECHS) are open-enrollment high schools that allow students least likely to attend college an opportunity to receive both a high school diploma and either an associate degree or at least 60 credit hours toward a baccalaureate degree. ECHS programs primarily focus on enrolling historically underserved students, targeting at-risk and economically disadvantaged students.
- UISD uses an online application portal.
- Students are selected via a performance blind lottery

 - 2017 -Biotechnology and Life Sciences Innovative Academy
 - 2021 -United South High School Early College High School



- Allow students to gain work experience through internships with our community partners: (Ruthe B. Cowl, LMC, Las Alturas, Ahh Smile, City of Laredo)







Associate of Science Degree Graduates




