WE HAVE ONE DRIVER DOING OUR REGISTRATION FOR US AT THE KW BERGAN. SHE ALSO RUNS THE BOOKMOBILE WHEN SHE'S NOT DOING REGISTRATION. WE HAVE ANOTHER DRIVER THAT SUBS ON THE BOOKMOBILE WHEN NEEDED.

WE GOT A NEW PRESSURE WASHER INSTALLED IT IS WORKING GREAT. IT HAS A LOT MORE PRESSURE THAN THE OLD ONE.

WE GOT ALL OUR FIRE EXTINGUISHERS CHARGED UP FOR THE BUSES WHEN THEY GET INSPECTED AND OUR FIRST AID KITS GOT UPDATED.

WE HAD TO BRING BUS #521 TO HARLOWS IN KALISPELL TO GET THE AIR COMPRESSOR AND FOUR WHEEL DRIVE UNIT REPAIRED.

SOME OF THE WINDSHIELDS IN THE DISTRICT VEHICLES GOT REPLACED AND SOME IN THE BUSES ALSO.

WE PURCHASED A NEW BATTERY CHARGER FOR THE FORKLIFT AT THE FOOD SERVICE PROGRAM'S WAREHOUSE THE COST WAS \$1,194.00.

WE HAD OUR COUNTY MEETING WITH THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT MR. OMSBERG AND ALL OUR ROUTES WERE APPROVED FOR THE 2017-2018 SCHOOL YEAR.
