## Pritzker Signs SB 28, Instructional Day Compromise Bill

As we hoped, Governor JB Pritzker today signed SB 28, allowing school leaders to proceed with finalizing school calendars.

The legislation reinstates the 5-hour instructional day mandate as it existed while creating exceptions to that requirement for students to engage in learning opportunities outside of the classroom. SB 28, now Public Act 101-0012, is effective July 1, 2019.

The exceptions to the five-hour instructional day requirement are for students participating in dual credit, internships, youth apprenticeships or blended learning programs, as well as the expansion of e-learning flexibility statewide. In addition, the legislation allows districts to use two of the 176 school calendar days for parent-teacher conference days.

We appreciate the governor's office understanding the sense of urgency with getting this legislation signed. I also want to applaud the bill's sponsor, Senator Jennifer Bertino-Tarrant, D-Shorewood, for her leadership and willingness to listen to concerns superintendents had with the initial version of the bill. In the end, we landed on a compromise that I believe is a win-win for everyone.

We will continue to follow when other pieces of legislation get signed by the governor and update you on the details.
