SUMMARY: Senate Bill (SB) 12 from the 89th Legislative Session addressed parental rights in public education and requires certification of compliance with provisions of the Education Code regarding (1) instruction and (2) diversity, equity, and inclusion (DEI) duties. Not later than September 30 of each year, the Superintendent of a school district shall certify to the Texas Education Agency (TEA) that the district is in compliance. See attached certification and supporting documents.
