News & Notes:

- The Spring/Summer Community Ed Catalog has been finalized and sent to the printer. It should be arriving in mailboxes around the 1st of April! The electronic version is available on our website.
- The District has received a grant through the American Rescue Plan that has to be spent by August 31st, 2022. We have been working collaboratively with the Principals, Business Office, and Superintendent to identify appropriate programming to use these funds and expand opportunities to the youth in our community. We are excited to start to promote and roll out these programs and hope that some of them will be able to be replicated in future summers.
- A new Community Ed registration form (paper) has been created and is available in the Community Ed

- We are exploring improving marketing emails & catalog distribution for future editions.
