






School SOCIAL WORKERS

INTERVENTIONS INCLUDE (BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO):



- **ATTENDANCE INTERVENTIONS:** PARENT/STUDENT CONTACT, FAMILY MEETINGS, COUNSELOR/ADMIN COLLABORATION, FAMILIES IN NEED OF SERVICES (FINS)
- **RESOURCES & FAMILY SUPPORT:** FOOD, CLOTHING, TRANSIT VOUCHERS, AND BASIC NEEDS
 - **FRIDAY CLOSET:** PROVIDING WEEKEND-READY SUPPLIES WHEN OTHER RESOURCES ARE UNAVAILABLE, SUPPORTED BY COMMUNITY GRANTS & CHURCH DONATIONS
- **CASE MANAGEMENT:** LIAISON WITH JUVENILE COURT, DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES, AND COMMUNITY AGENCIES; ONGOING FAMILY CONTACT FOR AT-RISK STUDENTS
- **BEHAVIOR INTERVENTIONS:** ELOPEMENT, ESCALATION SUPPORT, 1:1 INTERVENTION, THREAT ASSESSMENTS, CRISIS RESPONSE, SMALL GROUPS, INTENSIVE CASE MANAGEMENT
- **SCHOOL SUPPORT:** ADDRESS VERIFICATION, HOME VISITS, PARENT CONTACT, FACULTY/STAFF SUPPORT


School SOCIAL WORKERS Interventions Data **FALL OF 2025**





FSPS SCHOOL NURSE MISSION

To build a bridge between the school and community in order to provide a positive difference in the health and well being of our students

FSPS SCHOOL NURSE ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Incorporate standards of practice that are foundational for evidence based, clinically competent, quality care
- Provide leadership in the development of policies, programs and procedures for the provision of school health services
- Promote community/ public health and disease prevention
- Collaborate in care coordination between the education and medical communities

School NURSES

Clinical Care & Student Support

- Practice under Arkansas State Board of Nursing guidelines
- Act as the medical officer for each campus
- Assess and manage student health needs and injuries
- Manage chronic conditions, medications, and nursing procedures



Screenings, Planning & Prevention

- Conduct required vision, hearing, scoliosis, and BMI screenings
- Develop individualized health care plans and school health policies
- Promote disease prevention and student wellness



Education, Coordination & Safety

- Provide health education to students, families, and staff
- Coordinate emergency care and participate on campus crisis teams
- Serve as liaison between schools, families, and healthcare providers




