- **What is the mission of the non-profit/community organization?**

Camp Conquest is a Christian camp that provides life-changing experiences for campers with special needs, chronic illnesses, and disabilities, including Disabled Veterans.

- **What service(s) does the non-profit/community organization provide?** Overnight camp experience with activities that include horseback riding, zip line, rock climbing wall, giant swing, lake slide, canoeing, archery, volleyball, basketball, swimming.
- **Please describe the volunteer activities students will participate in at the non-profit/community organization and how those activities may connect to curriculum learning goals.**

Counselors are paired up with campers for the week, day and night. We have 5 campers, 5 counselors, and 2 cabin leaders in each cabin. The counselors provide support for the camper by helping in the morning to get dressed, brush their teeth, assist them during meal times, they encourage the camper to try the different activities, take them to the medical station if they need medical attention. The counselors sleep on the bunk above their camper. If the camper needs medical attention in the night or needs assistance, the counselor will help them. The counselor ensures that the camper has the best week at camp.

We have had many students (counselors) that have changed their major to special education after volunteering at Camp Conquest.

- **What are the non-profit/community organization procedures and policies to ensure the safety of student volunteers?** All volunteers are required to arrive on Sunday each week of camp for training. Campers arrive at 4:30 pm on Monday. Training will include medical diagnosis so counselors have a knowledge about their campers medical conditions, proper wheelchair transfer, sexual abuse & awareness, seizure procedures, buddy system procedures (counselors must have a third person with them and the camper), inclement weather procedures, and activity safety.

We are a Christian organization so we do not require volunteers to share our beliefs but we do ask volunteers to be positive influences and encourage our students to chase their God given dreams.
