Members of the board,

As the principal at East, I am concerned about the student attendance rates dropping for the current school year. We have been thinking of different ways to encourage students to not be absent from school.

East would like to reward students per grade level on attendance, grades, and behavior. We will track and display how grade levels are doing based on attendance, grades, and behavior to motivate students to do well. Grade levels have the opportunity to earn points based on the following criteria:

- 1) A point will be rewarded each week to the grade level with the highest attendance percentage.
- 2) A point will be rewarded each week to the grade level with the highest percentage of students with all passing grades.
- 3) A point will be rewarded each week to the grade level with the fewest detentions/suspensions.

At the end of each trimester, the grade level with the most points will earn a reward party with some sort of treat (potentially pizza, ice cream, or candy bar).

East would also like to reward students on an individual basis. Students with only one absence per trimester would be entered in a drawing to earn prizes (such as gift cards or certificates). We would like a total amount of \$1,500 (\$500 per trimester) to use to purchase the rewards.

Per your request- Attendance Incentive Proposal

- 1) Dance at the end of the school year for students who miss 10 days or fewer total- \$500
- 2) Pizza and Pop during Advisory- once a month for perfect attendance - \$400 a month
- 3) Drawing for an iPad- one per trimester- for perfect attendance- \$400-\$600 per trimester

Minico High School Attendance Policy

- Students will be required to attend, at a minimum, 90% of assigned school days.
- Students will be allowed to miss 6 days during a trimester, and 10 days during the semester.
- A letter will be sent home to the students who have exceeded the 90% rule.
- Students who exceed the 90% rules will be required to write an appeal letter to an attendance committee outlining the reasons for their absences.
- Students will have two weeks to prepared and submit appeal letter after receiving their notice of appeal.
- Guidelines for letter, as well as sample letters, will be provided to the students.
- The committee will review the letters to determine if:
 1. The student will receive credit for the class
 2. The student will receive credit for the class but be placed on an attendance contract which outlines that if the student exceeds the 90% rule in the next term they will lose credit for the previous term.
 3. The student will be denied credit.
- It is proposed that committee consist of a teacher, a counselor, an administrator and a school board member.
- The committee will convene and review appeal letters at the end of each trimester and semester.

Minico High School Attendance Incentives Proposal

1. Once per month, students with 6 or less absences and 3 or less tardies will be given an hour long lunch.
2. Once per month, students with 3 or less absences and 3 or less tardies will be eligible for a drawing for (2) \$25 Amazon Gift Cards and (1) \$25 Gas Card per grade level. ***The Drawing for the Freshman Class will consist of (3) \$25 Amazon Gift Cards due to the fact that few Freshmen would benefit from a gas card.***
3. Students with 2 or less absences (trimester class) and 3 or less absences (semester class), 3 tardies or less and at least 80% grade in the class can opt out of the end of course final. ***Students enrolled in a dual credit class will still have to take the final since it is required by the college.***
4. Each trimester, the grade level with the best attendance will receive a treat for the entire grade. This will be paid for with school funds

Respectfully requesting a budget of \$2,500.00

Mt. Harrison--Incentives--2016-17

Mt. Harrison's incentives will be based primarily around attendance and trying to increase overall attendance at the school. The goal is to get overall attendance to 90%. We feel that if students are in the classroom they will make progress in academics. If attendance increases we feel it will help test scores and the graduation rate.

Incentive Proposals

- #1. Casual Fridays--To start the year, we have set a goal of 86% attendance. We will look at this in 3 week time periods. If the overall student body reaches that goal, then on Friday of the 3rd week, students can have a casual Friday, meaning they do not have to wear the uniform on that Friday.
- #2. Monetary Incentives--Beginning the second week of each quarter we will put names in a box for a drawing to be held at the end of each quarter. Every 2 weeks we will select students who have had perfect attendance for that 2 week time period. At the end of the quarter we will hold a drawing. We will select one name from each grade level who had perfect attendance. Each student drawn will receive a \$25.00 gift card. We will also draw one name of an individual who has had perfect attendance for at least one 2 week period of time, but does not have perfect attendance for the whole quarter. This will allow us to recognize some students who have done well with attendance, but have not reached perfect attendance for the whole quarter. We would also like to draw a name from all of these students for an iPad mini.
- #3. Each quarter hold a pizza party, ice cream/root beer party for those students who have a GPA of 2.75 or higher or students who met the 90% attendance mark for the quarter.

Dear Dr. Cox and School Board;

The Total Learning Center would like to establish a goal for 95% attendance, and utilize the following incentives:

Elementary School:
