

Consideration for Authorization to Sell Surplus Portable

As a result of renovations, the District has no need for one (1) surplus portable located on the Temple High School Campus.

State law requires school districts to offer each open-enrollment charter school located within district boundaries the opportunity to acquire any surplus district facilities prior to offering the facilities to the general public. The school board is not required to accept the offer from the charter school but must at least consider it. Following that offer to any charter schools, the District may also solicit the sale of surplus facilities to the general public though an open bid process.

Recommendation: Authorize the administration to offer one (1) surplus portable for sale to any open-enrollment charter school operating with Temple ISD boundaries and if no such charter school expresses interest, offer the portables to the general public through an open bid process.
