





Please note the following regarding "Extra-Duty" pay:

- As a general rule, administrators should never be paid extra for work performed during their contract period. The job responsibility of an administrator is purposely broad to include any work performed for Cedar Hill ISD. Therefore, pay authorizations should rarely be completed for an administrator.
- Compensatory time may be given to "non-exempt" employees in lieu of overtime compensation for the overtime work. The employee shall be informed in advance if overtime hours will accrue compensatory time rather than monetary pay. (DEA Local)
- 3. The minimum wage and overtime provisions do not apply to any employee employed in a bona fide executive, administrative, or professional capacity, including academic administrative personnel or teachers in elementary or secondary school. (DEA Legal). Therefore, the District will refrain from giving compensatory time to these "exempt" employees.


