

# **Executive Summary**

### Introduction

The InterMountain Education Service District serves 18 component school districts in Baker, Morrow, Umatilla and Union counties. We serve 23,450 students in eastern Oregon.

### **Resolution Services & the Local Service Plan**

The IMESD is legislatively mandated to provide four core areas of service to students and schools:

- 1. Programs for children with special needs
- i. Trograms for children with special needs
- 2. Technology support

- 3. Instructional services
- 4. Administrative & other services

### **General Fund/Resolution Services**

The following services in the core areas are considered Resolution Services. They are funded through the General Fund and provided at no cost to component school districts:

### 1. Programs for children with special needs:

- Audiology: audiologist & audiometric technicians
- Nursing: Special Education
- Speech-Language Pathology Services: consultation, evaluation, therapy
- School Psychology & Behavioral Services: consultation, evaluation

## 2. Technology support:

- Business & Student software payments
- E-rate
- Network Support to supplement District contracts
- Desktop Support to supplement District contracts
- Technology Purchasing
- Student Technology Intern Program

#### 3. Instructional services:

- Teacher Services: teacher mentors, instructional coaching, new teacher cadre
- Early College & Workforce Development: Eastern Promise, Career & Technical Education (CTE)
- InterMountain Online
- School Security
- Federal Grants Collections
- Grants: grant writer
- · Home School: maintain home school reporting

#### 4. Administrative & other services:

- Superintendent Services: consultation, networking, training
- Business Services: business consultation
- Human Resources: consultation, investigations, legal services, unemployment claims
- Facilities: consultation, safety plans, lead testing, asbestos, Outdoor School
- · Cooperative Purchasing: purchasing, warehouse, courier
- Communication & Print Solutions: general communication, website development & management, graphic design, print shop, translation services, Crisis Flight Team
- CARE Coordinators, Nurse Consultation, Wellness Hubs
- Medicaid Administrative Claiming
