Questions:

- Due to safety, will upstairs classroom doors at Minico be replaced? The doors currently have to be locked from the outside. (Will be added to the list)
- Was the \$16 million it showed on the spreadsheet only for repairs to Minico? (Yes)
- Has it been considered to have a "satellite" food service at one school to prepare all the food, then sent to all other schools?
- At East and West, they are over capacity. It shows office being remodeled for security reasons and classrooms added, but what can be done for the overcrowding in the cafeteria and gym for assemblies? (This will be added to the list and discussed with the architects).
- If a new high school is built, can grade levels be moved into what is currently East and West to help with the overcrowding in elementary schools.
- If an elementary school is built, has it been discussed about putting it off of 21st street in the Heyburn area?
- Adding classrooms to elementary schools, but will they filled to capacity in a few years?

 - Separate cafeteria
 - Larger gym, multi-purpose room
- Heyburn
 - Separate cafeteria
 - Larger gym/ multi-purpose room

Pat Swigert, Maintenance Supervisor, explained the way some roofs are on buildings will limit where either of these additions can be added.

- Parking lot and parent pick up
- East Minico
 - Changes needed for gym and cafeteria-expand cafeteria to include entrance to auditorium
- West Minico
 - Changes needed for gym and cafeteria-expand cafeteria to include entrance to auditorium
- Mt. Harrison
 - Additional large classroom for Family and Consumer Science
- Minico
 - Commons area
 - Doors replaced in classrooms
