NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE WYLIE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT that the Competitive Sealed Proposals method of delivery is determined to provide the best value for the District on the Project.
