Note: The grievance procedure exists in AC-AR.  <b>Committee Decision: Update as per OSBA</b>
<b>ACA – REVISED</b> Sep. 2010	<b>Americans with Disabilities Act</b> (TRSD adopted in 2006)	<b>OPTIONAL.</b> Adds relevant legal references, a statement that bans retaliation against an individual making a discrimination complaint and adds in compliance with 2008 legislation.  <b>Committee Decision: Update as per OSBA</b>
<b>AD – REVISED</b> (version #2) Sep. 2009 and Sep. 2011	<b>Educational Philosophy</b> (TRSD adopted in 2005)	<b>OPTIONAL.</b> Change in language responds to the requirement that grading practices reflect student achievement as compared to the standards at the student’s grade level.  <b>Committee Decision: Update as per OSBA</b>
<b>AE – REVISED</b> (version #2) Sep. 2009 and Sep. 2011 (revision May 2013 for version 3 only)	<b>District Goals</b> (TRSD adopted in 2007)	<b>RECOMMENDED.</b> Change in language responds to the requirement that grading practices reflect student achievement as compared to the standards at the student’s grade level and that districts utilize valid and reliable data in determining the success of the program.  <b>Committee Decision: Update as Per OSBA</b>
