ALIGNS TO BOARD PRIORITIES(S):

• Safety – The District will maintain a safe and orderly environment.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- At least once every three years all school districts are required to:
 - o conduct a safety and security audit of all the district's facilities;
 - o report the audit findings to the Texas School Safety Center; and
 - o report the audit findings to the Board of Trustees in executive session.
- The Director of Student Services and Safety, along with the Chief of Police, will
 present information on the status of internal audit results from the 2014-2015
 school year.
- To the extent possible, a district shall follow safety and security procedures developed by the Texas School Safety Center or a comparable private entity.
- Texas Government Code Sec. 551.076 DELIBERATION REGARDING SECURITY DEVICES <u>OR SECURITY AUDITS</u>; CLOSED MEETING. This chapter does not require a governmental body to conduct an open meeting to deliberate:
 - (1) the deployment, or specific occasions for implementation, of security personnel or devices or
 - (2) a security audit
