Subject: Consider Approval of 2023 Bond First-Sale Student Information System (SIS) – Cooperative Contract(s) (TC02)

Background Information:

- The Board of Trustees approved ESC Region 19 RFP #17-7247 Allied States Cooperative – Student and Finance Systems – Skyward on March 20, 2023, for a three-year agreement through August 31, 2026.
- The Board of Trustees also approved the District’s migration to the new Skyward Qmlativ SIS platform on September 9, 2024, which continued the established pricing agreement through August 31, 2026, and established negotiated pricing for the system’s modules.
- After completing the migration, the District will begin using the new Skyward Qmlativ SIS system in July 2026. This solution meets all the state requirements and provides critical functions needed by the District, such as Teacher Grade Books, Health Services, Student Services, Special Education, Attendance, and Student Scheduling.
- A three-year agreement is recommended to help manage increased costs and provide the best value to the District. The agreement freezes per-student pricing for most line items, but overall costs could vary based upon future enrollment numbers.
- Best value involves considering several factors, which may include, but are not limited to, price, quality, availability, delivery timing, support, and other relevant factors.

Administrative Consideration:

- Funds for this purchase will come from the 2023 Technology Bond budget.
- Previous annual expenditures: (2025–2026) \$571,050 (enrollment of 47,876)
 - This included a Hosting fee, Core subscription, license, Fee tracking license, new student online enrollment, LMS-API license, Skylert Interface, Crystal Reports license, training, and Student Professional Development Center.
- Anticipated annual expenditures: (2026–2027) \$494,478 (estimated enrollment 47,500)
 - This includes a Hosting fee, Core subscription license & support, Fee tracking license, new student online enrollment, LMS-API license, and Student Professional Development Center.
- Estimated total expenditures: \$1,483,433 for a three-year period to be paid annually but will not exceed approved budgets.
- This procurement complies with Section 44.031 of the Texas Education Code and applicable state and local procurement laws.

Recommendations:

- That the Lewisville ISD Board of Trustees approves the estimated expenditure for the 2023 Bond First-Sale Student Information System (SIS), utilizing a Lewisville ISD-eligible cooperative contract for a three-year term with the awarded vendor.
