Re: Gymnasium Lighting Bid Results

We would like to discuss the gymnasium lighting bid results for Buchanan, Garfield, Hoover, Kennedy, Randolph Elementary Schools and the Maintenance and Warehouse buildings at the Building and Site Committee meeting on Monday, May 6, 2013.

We discussed this project at our recent Building and Site sub-committee meeting on April 22, 2013. This is a continuation of the lighting project we completed in four school buildings last year; Cooper, Grant, Hayes Elementary Schools and the Western Wayne Skill Center. We have also attached a copy of the memo dated February 26, 2013 discussing the project in detail.

We are recommending the low bidders for electrical and painting as per the District Engineer's recommendation (attached) for a total cost of \$175,904. For the electrical work, we have selected the lowest vendor for each building. Each of the vendors agreed to the partial project. By using this selection project, the District will realize savings of just over \$5,000. This is detailed on the attached spreadsheet and bid tabulation.

Re: Gym Lighting

After reviewing the Gym Lighting Project bids submitted on April 16, 2013, I am recommending the project be awarded to three contractors for the electrical work and one contractor for the painting work. My recommendation for the electrical work is:

- Allied Building Service of Detroit to perform the electrical work at Buchanan Hoover, Kennedy, and the Maintenance Building for a combine bid of \$49,304
- Shoreview Electric of Clinton Twp to perform the electrical work at Randolph and the Warehouse for a combine bid of \$57,000
- Corby Energy Services of Belleville to perform the electrical work at Garfield for a bid of \$19,630

The combined total cost for the electrical bid is \$125,934. By awarding contracts to three different contractors, the school district will save \$5,351.

I recommend that the painting contract for the five schools be awarded to Chirri Building of Northville for the low bid of \$49,970.

The total lighting and painting project in seven buildings is \$175,904. If you have any questions regarding this bid recommendation, please contact me at ext 42158.
