Contract Award Recommendation for Abatement Bids Cooper Upper Elementary School and Frost Middle School

Dear Ms. Abbey:

This letter transmits an update from Plante Moran Cresa (PMC) as it relates to the assignment to assist and advise Livonia Public Schools (LPS) in its selection of Prime Contractors for the Projects listed above. This update represents the mutual efforts of PMC, ETC Environmental and LPS administration and staff (the Bond Team) to present a framework in order to identify, evaluate and recommend Prime Contractors firms for this Project.

On February 10, 2014 Construction Documents were formally issued and made available. An advertisement for bids was published in a local newspaper and also posted to the required State of Michigan websites.

On February 27, 2014 9 bid proposals were received from 6 separate firms, and over the next several days were reviewed to determine the budget implications. Interviews were held over the next week and were attended by various members of the Bond Team.

Upon completion of the interviews, and after subsequent clarifications and discussions, the Bond Team is recommending the firms listed in ETC Environmental's Award Recommendation Letter dated February 28, 2014 for contract award. Including hard construction, CM fees and costs, and construction contingency dollars, the total Project award recommendation equals \$606,955.00. This does not include environmental consulting fees, which were previously awarded and will be paid out of a separate budget.

For the Abatement Contractors, the costs for this work will be detailed in a Purchase Order issued by the District, pending final review and approval by district legal counsel.

The Project Team is available at the Board's convenience to answer any questions regarding bidding, the interview process, or the recommendations of the Bond Team. Please direct all questions through me via email.



RE: Award Recommendations for Frost Middle and Cooper Upper Elementary Schools for Asbestos Abatement Contractors

Per your request, please allow this letter to serve as Environmental Testing and Consulting's (ETC) recommendations for award of asbestos abatement work at Frost Middle and Cooper Upper Elementary Schools. ETC (in conjunction with Mr. Jim Mc Muldroch of Livonia Public Schools (LPS)) has completed contractor interviews with the two lowest qualified bidders at both schools.

Regarding Cooper Upper Elementary, contractor interviews were conducted with ALAM Inc and Quality Abatement. At these interviews each contractor discussed their work plan, proposed staffing, bonding requirements and other items that pertained to the completion of the abatement project.

After careful review of all the pertinent information, ETC would recommend that Cooper Upper Elementary School be awarded to the low bidder Quality Abatement of Gladwin, Michigan for a total cost of \$138,200.00.

Regarding Frost Middle School, contractor interviews were conducted with Quality Abatement and Qualified Abatement. At these interviews each contractor discussed their work plan, proposed staffing, bonding requirements and other items that pertained to the completion of the abatement project.

Quality Abatement was the low bidder at \$207,670 this price was 44% below the next bidder. Additionally, ETC has significant concerns regarding their ability to complete the project based upon the submitted work plan. Their plan involves 15 abatement staff for 5 days per week working 8 hour days (Total of 3000 labor hours). They propose to work the weekends if they fall behind the proposed schedule. Although they propose to use machines to speed up the process, this abatement schedule does not seem to be sufficient to complete the proposed work.

By comparison, the second bidder (Qualified Abatement) is proposing 13-15 abatement staff for 7 days per week working 8 hour days (Total of 3600-4200 labor hours) and indicated that they would go to a second shift. This labor total appears to be more in keeping with the requirements.

ETC has included \$5000 per day liquidated damages for each school to help insure the work is completed on-time. However, if the selected contractor falls behind implementing these damages will not help the general contractor complete all work by the beginning of the next school year. Given the strategic importance of completing this work on schedule to allow appropriate time for the rebuilding, ETC would recommend that Frost Middle School be awarded to Qualified Abatement of Detroit, Michigan for a total cost of \$367,596.00.
