WE STARTED TO CLEAN BUSES GETTING THEM READY FOR BUS INSPECTION WHICH WILL BE IN JULY AND WE STARTED TO RUN OUR ACTIVITIES BUSES FOR THE SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAM WE HAVE A DRIVER THAT WORKS OUT OF FOOD SERVICES TO DRIVE THE FOOD BUS FOR THEM FOR THE SUMMER.

WE HAD TO SEND BUS #2119 TO AL'S DIESEL IN CUTBANK FOR REPAIRS IT WASN'T RUNNING RIGHT AND IT KEEPS THROWING CODES WE THINK IT MIGHT BE THE BATTERIES. THEY WILL CHECK THESE AND GET BACK TO US.

THE MECHANICS BEEN BUSY SERVICING AND REPAIRING DISTRICT VEHICLES ALONG WITH TRYING TO GET THE MECHANICAL DEFECTS REPAIRED ON THE BUSES BEFORE INSPECTION GETS HERE. THEY BEEN REPAIRING SEATS AND WINDSHIELDS AS WELL.
