Give your child a strong start by enrolling them in one (or more!) of the many **early education and child care options** available based on your child's age:

For Ages 0–3

- Early Head Start / Head Start
- State-Funded Preschool
- Alternative Payment Program
- Licensed Center or Home
- Family, Friend, or Neighbor Caregiver

For Ages 4–5*

- Head Start
- State-Funded Preschool
- Transitional Kindergarten (TK)
- Alternative Payment Program
- Licensed Center or Home
- Family, Friend, or Neighbor Caregiver

Things to Consider When Making Your Choice

What is available for my child?
What options are best for me and my child?

What is Transitional Kindergarten (TK)?

Transitional Kindergarten provides an opportunity for children, who are 4 and 5* years old, to access an early education program. Some school districts may also accept children outside of the eligible 4 and 5 year old age range for early enrollment.
