School Library Learning Spaces

Biennial Budget

The Joint Finance Committee has wrapped up the listening sessions and continues its work considering specific areas of the budget, such as Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection, Environmental Improvement Fund and the Department of Natural Resources. We are anticipating Education will be one of the last items of the budget to be addressed, but hopeful the process will keep moving forward in a timely manner.

Northwood Technical College Graduates

According to the most recent graduate survey, the following relates to 2021-22 Northwood Tech College graduates:

- 94% were placed (either employed or furthering their education as a student) six months after graduation
- \$51,781 is the average salary for graduates who are employed full-time in a
 job related to their training This is up from \$46,000 from the previous
 survey.
 - \$74,788 Industrial Maintenance Technician
 - \$70,693 Nursing Associate Degree
 - \$66,733 Truck Driving
 - \$66,722 Automation for Industrial Systems
 - \$60,216 Welding
- 62% of graduates work in Wisconsin
- 51% of graduates work in the Northwood Tech eleven-county district
