- Expanded Capturing Kids Hearts practices and strategies campus-wide as indicated in the Process of Champions in order to continue a culture of acceptance, community and family at school.
- Added sections of Pre-Athletics to accommodate more students in the athletic program
- Addition of Software such as IXL to aid with our Accelerated Instruction efforts as dictated by the Student Success Initiative.
- Host two annual Title 1 campus meetings with parents to explain the following: Gilbert
 Intermediate Title 1 Part A participation and requirements, the state curriculum in use,
 the forms of academic assessments and proficiency levels students are expected to
