The subject areas of this project include band, guitar, orchestra, choir, and musical theater. In order to help the classroom run smoothly, having students step into another room to record their playing allows the teacher to continue class and then watch the performance later, focusing on the specific aspects of each players' performance and giving quality feedback. In addition, the recording devices can be used to record the ensemble on a regular basis to track progress, and can also be used to record concerts for educational purposes to be shown to the students for them to provide feedback.
