Preliminary data from a California study found that children who were chronically absent in kindergarten and 1st grade were far less likely to read proficiently at the end of 3rd grade.*

We have had a decline in attendance since the winter break due to sickness and we are hoping with your support that we can get "on track" until June. So, please help us educate and prepare your children for their future by making sure they are at school on a regular basis this year and in the future!!!!!!
