1. Call to Order @ 4:44pm
  - In-person attendance – Tina Steffen, Nicole Nelson, Bonnie Morris, Josh Andrews, David Harris
  - Zoom attendance – Art Frank, Shauna Thomas
  - We switched the two (2) agenda items around so Tina could get to basketball practice.
  
2. FY24 & FY25 Review of CCSD Indian Education Policies & Procedures
  - The Indian Education Policies and Procedures (IPP) reviewed by the IEC last year were approved by the CCSD School Board, but weren't signed. Jackie reviewed the Board Summary with the IEC. Jackie needs to get the IPPs signed for CCSD's FY25 Impact Aid Application. Jackie inquired about parent representatives. It was mentioned Ricki and Kayla attended some meetings last year; hence, Jackie will follow up with them for signatures.
  - The IEC didn't have any changes to the IPPs for next year; hence, the IPPs were updated to reflect FY26 and signed. Jackie will be sure they are included as an agenda item at the CCSD School Board meeting on January 15, 2025. Once approved, Jackie will be sure the IPPs are signed by all parties and will upload the new IPPs to the website as well as submit them to be included as part of CCSD's Impact Aid Application.
  
3. Cultural Basketball Tournament (Tina Steffen)
  - Tina reviewed the schedule for the first Cultural Basketball Tournament, which will be hosted by CCSD! Next year Wrangell will host. The hope is the tourney would travel around SE Alaska with different communities hosting.
  - The tourney is scheduled for January 23-25, 2025. Tina has spoken with Justna at CTA about ideas and is seeing what the district/school is able to help with as well.
  - Tina shared ideas for the possibility of fry bread and a showing of the Healing Heart Totem Video as well as the possibility for Haida Dancers and Gambling Song (for CHS Basketball

- Josh will bring tourney notes/schedule back to staff to relay the tourney plans. Josh will relay to Jessica the need for concessions during the tourney. Bonnie will ask for volunteers on Saturday for lunch. Art said he's willing to help out as well.
- Tina will ask Ronnie about the possibility of making awards. Josh showed us the paddles Ronnie made for The Clark Tourney in Ketchikan. Jackie will ask Ronnie about how our SEALS students may be able to help as well and will connect with Tina.
