- Adoption of a character education program
- Contract with Crux for next steps on District Safety Planning
- Safety measures in place for ongoing Construction at High School and Gilbert campuses
- Revamp the SISD Comprehensive Safety and Security Plan
- Update the SISD Strategic Plan
- Expand CTE pathways at HJH
- Implement salary increase requirements of House Bill 3 and projections exceed requirements for all employees
- Increase the bilingual stipend to attract and retain bilingual certified teachers
- Continue implementation of Capturing Kids Hearts Program at campuses to ensure safe, nurturing, and efficient academic environments
- Implement the "SMART tag" student tracking system designed for school buses to
 ensure authorized and actual real time ridership for improved safety. Secondary benefits
 include is the use of the same student tag to more efficiently process students through
 the cafeteria line, as well as having campus differentiated lanyards providing additional
 safety awareness
- SISD Cash Control Procedures will be implemented and all new staff that handle cash will receive the SISD Cash Control Training.
- Three-Point Harnesses added to the school buses for additional safety for our Pre-Kindergarten Students
- Implement HB 496 involving "Stop the Bleed" training and purchasing of required kits
- Utilize Gaggle to monitor student Google accounts in grades 7-12 to provide awareness
 of potential harm to self or others. Appropriate staff will follow the identified response and
 documentation procedures to ensure safety.
