March is a time of transition between winter and spring and so much of the news this month is about endings and beginnings. Our winter sports seasons are coming to a close. 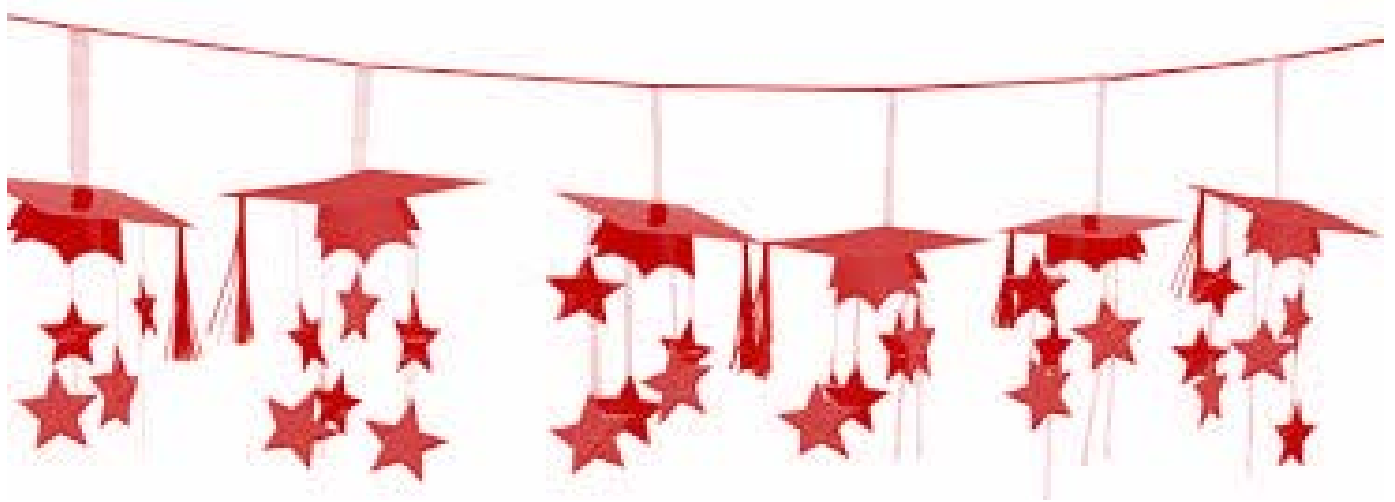
We are in the beginning stages of setting our master schedule for next year. We will be advising students over the next several weeks about the process for them to schedule their next set of classes.
