Grant Title: 2021-2022 COVID-19 School Health Support Grant, from the US Department of Health and Human Services/Center for Disease Control, passed through to the Texas Department of Health Services and the Texas Education Agency

Coordinating Department(s): Safety and Student Support Services, CFO, Business/Finance, Student Health Services, Facilities

Purpose: To support safe, in-person instruction in schools, from kindergarten through grade 12 (K-12), by establishing a screening testing program and by offering a grant opportunity to school systems for allowable support activities. The program provides services to students, teachers, and other school staff that include COVID-19 testing primarily for screening and testing to slow the spread of COVID-19.
