3A. Project Delivery Method and Purchase of Equipment for the Data Center Refresh

Jesse Garn, Executive Director of Technology, discussed items identified as Priority 1 in the bond package. The project timeline has been accelerated to avoid price increases as industry driven by AI datacenters has led to supply chain constraints and rising costs. He recommended to proceed with the Red River quote in the amount of \$1,065,327 to avoid surging prices.

4A. Approve Delivery Method and Authorize the Superintendent to Negotiate the Purchase of Equipment for the Data Center Refresh

Rick Tullis made a motion to approve construction delivery method and authorize the Superintendent to negotiate a contract for an amount not to exceed \$1.1 million to purchase equipment, software, licenses and associated other cost to accomplish the data center refresh. Colin Witt seconded the motion.
