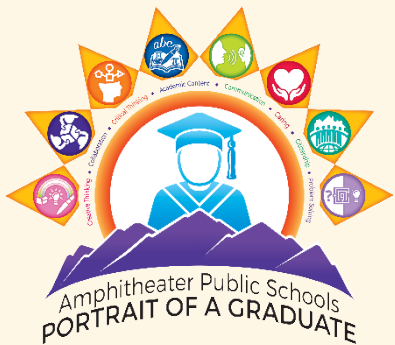

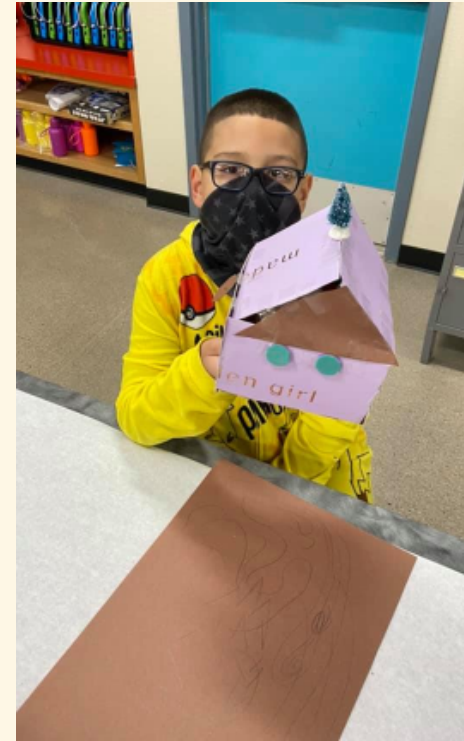
From Our Schools

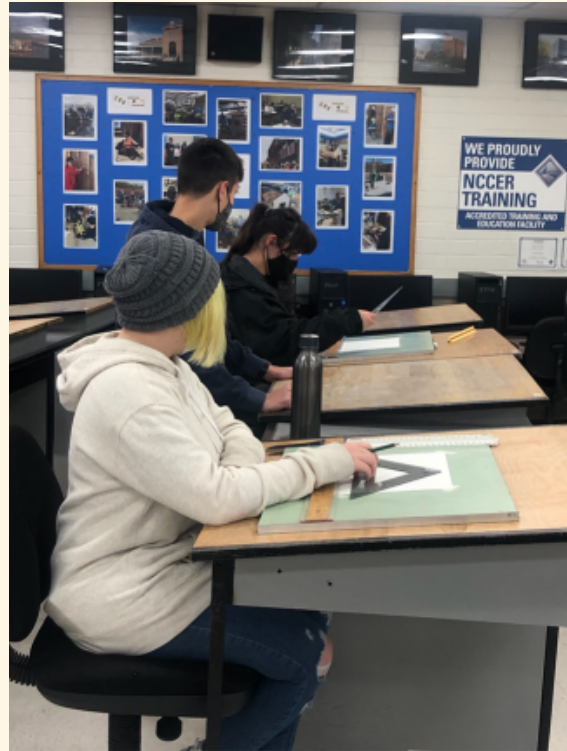

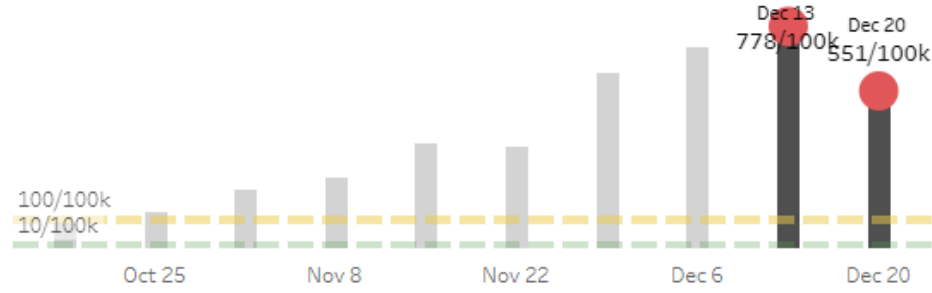




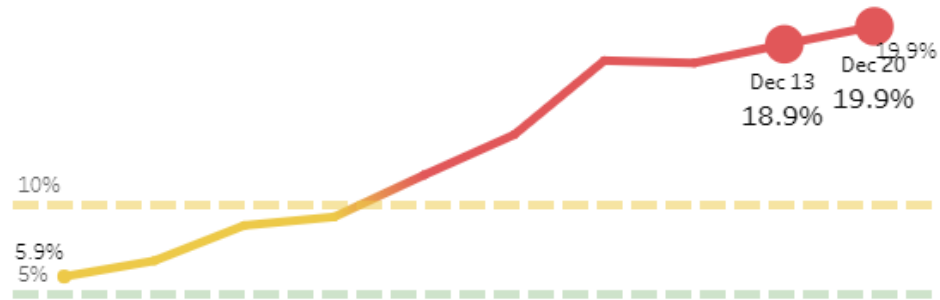
Showing data for **Pima County**

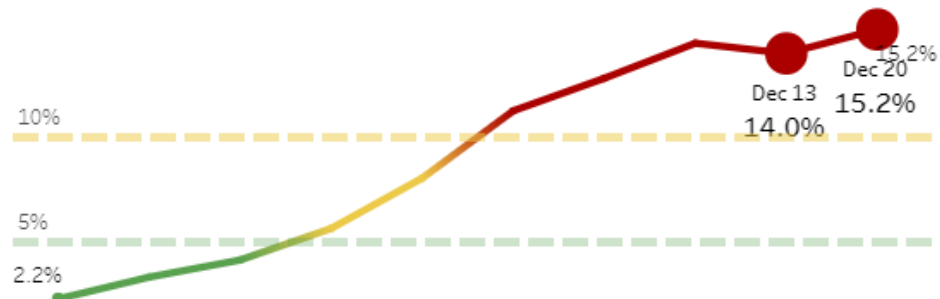
1) Cases per 100,000 individuals

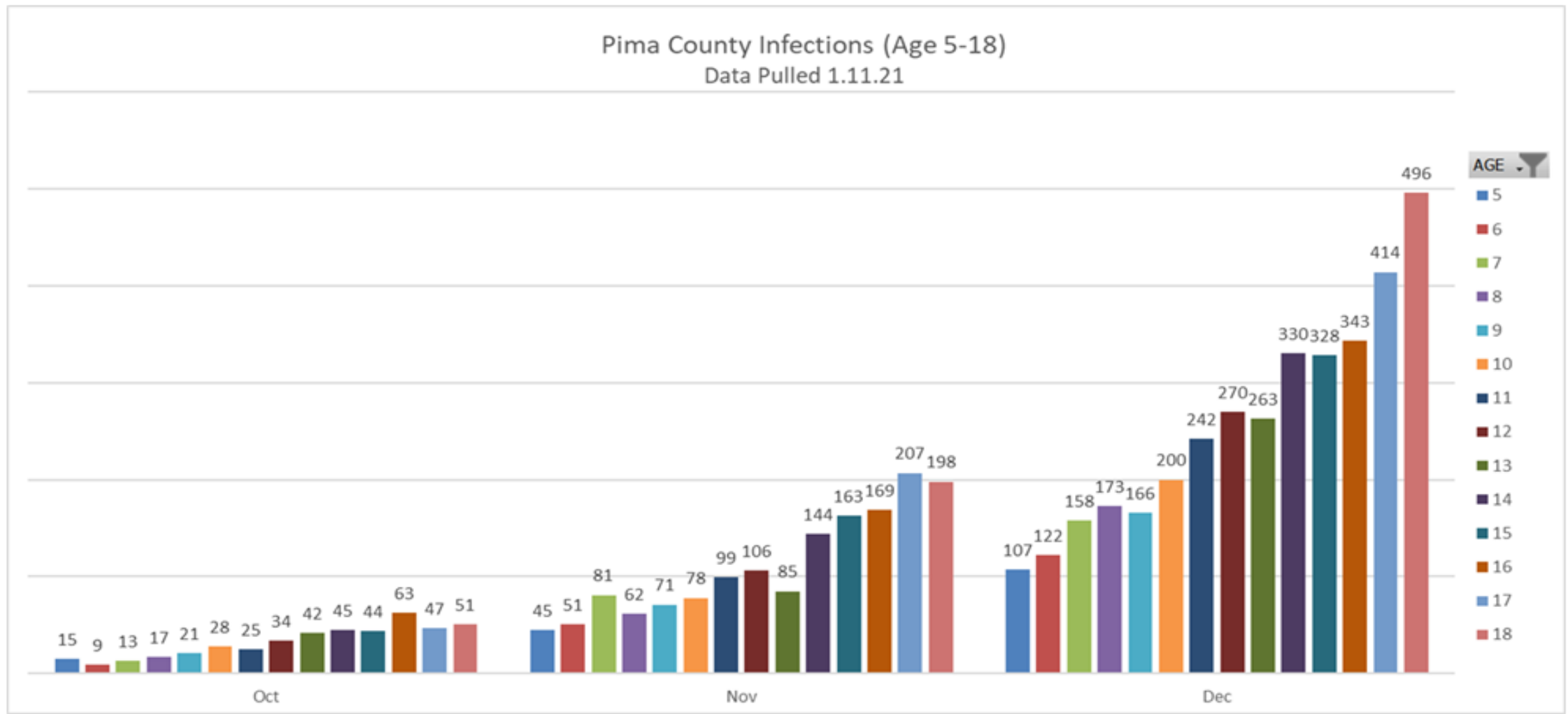

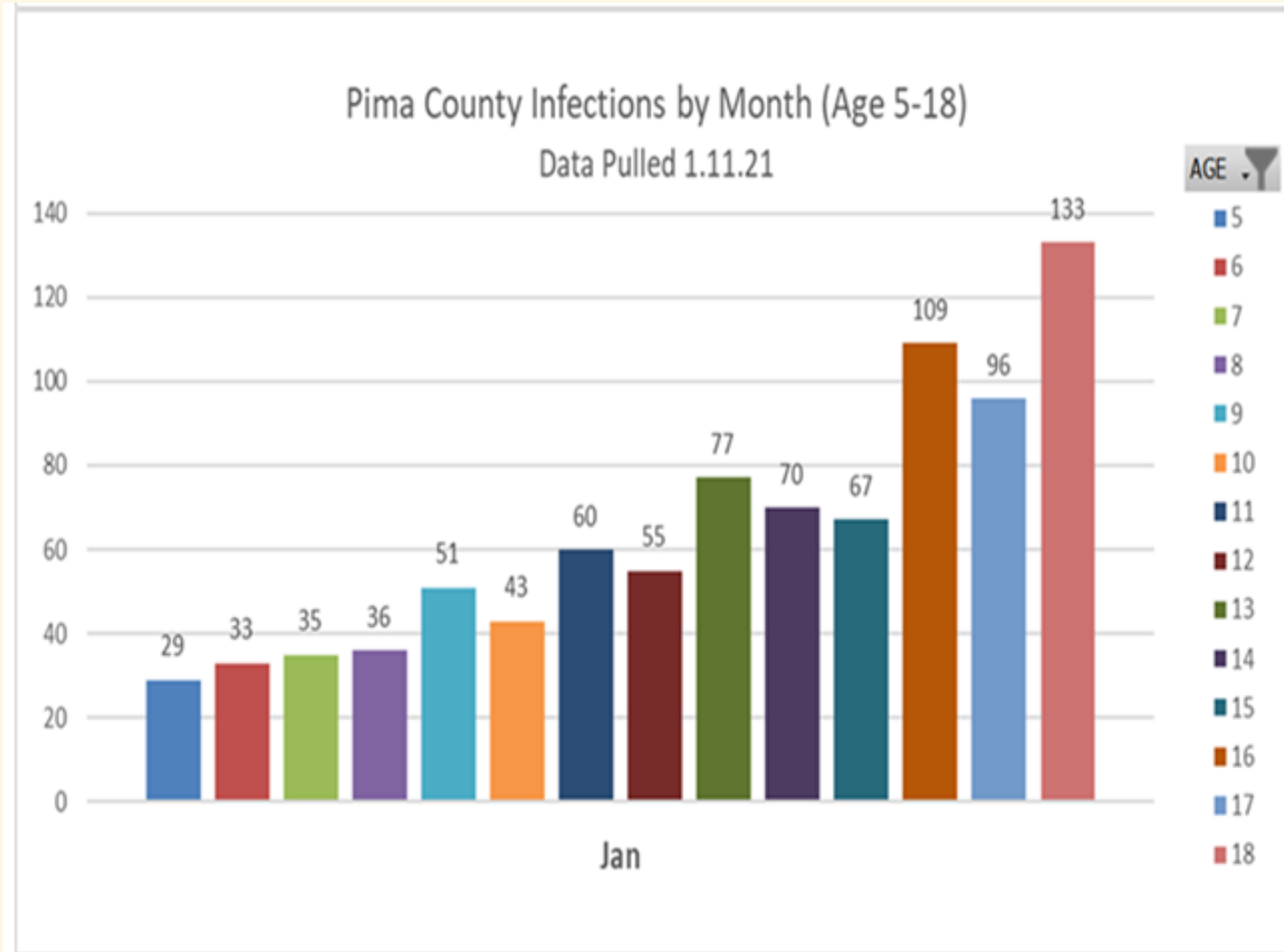
