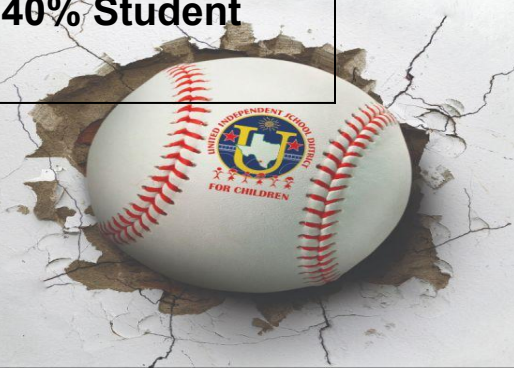


Key Performance Indicators - Targets for the Second Six-Weeks

1. **EL & MS: i-Ready targets in Reading and Math - Avg 35+ mins & 90% completion**
HS: 10% of Seniors are College Ready
2. **100% of Teachers receive at least One (1) Walkthrough per six-weeks**
3. **Campuses meet 65% (60% for HS) at Approaches, 40% at Meets, and 10% at Masters on the designated Checkpoint and Benchmark for HS at state standards for content areas assessed.**
4. **Growth is measured on Reading Language Arts and Math Assessments. Elementary and Middle School Campuses meet 45% Student Growth on designated checkpoint assessments. High Schools meet 40% Student Growth on Benchmark assessments.**
