The district is applying for a waiver that will allow the offering of Pregnancy-Related Services Compensatory Education Home Instruction on a designated campus. Transportation will be furnished if needed, and students will be served at home if medically necessary.

4. Describe the plan to be implemented, if the waiver is granted.

Pregnant students need to continue their education during and after pregnancy. Most students are supported by school staff and by the Health Services Department, they remain a the home campus until delivery or until the physician indicates otherwise. If medical complications arise and the physician indicates a necessity, they may be referred to homebound education. The program is conducted at a designated campus and is voluntary. Students may return to the home campus when cleared by the physician. The district ensures that the School Age Parent Program is comparable to that offered to non-pregnant students at the home campus. The School Age Parenting Program serves as a transition to keep students current in coursework so that a smooth transition to the home campus will be assured. Other services designed to assist the student parent are also provided. The aim of the program is to encourage student parents to remain in school until completion and not drop out.

5. How will granting this waiver help achieve the district's or campus' objective?

Parents will increase their ability to graduate via daycare at a facility close to campus; transportation for students and children; and instruction in child development and parenting

6. Please explain how the school district or campus will evaluate the impact of the waiver towards meeting the district's or campus' goal.

Data on CEHI student participants will be gathered to determine the number of students completing high school and those not completing high school.
