The School District received your Freedom of Information Act request on May 29, 2025. Your request and the School District's response are provided below.

**Request:** I am requesting access to the following public records:

1. The name of the vendor or organization currently contracted by the district to provide after-school care for students.  
Answer: Village of Riverside Parks & Recreation, and Village of Brookfield.
2. A copy of the current contract, agreement, or memorandum of understanding between the school district and the vendor providing after-school care.

3. The dates the current contract began and is set to expire.

4. Any addendums or amendments to the contract that have been executed since its inception.

To the extent you interpret this response as a denial of your request, you have the right to have the denial reviewed by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) at the Office of the Illinois Attorney General. 5 ILCS 140/9.5(a). You can file your Request for Review with the PAC by contacting the PAC at: Public Access Counselor, Office of the Attorney General; 500 South 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, Springfield, Illinois 62706; Fax: 217-782-1396; E-mail: [publicaccess@atg.state.il.us](mailto:publicaccess@atg.state.il.us); Phone: 1-877-299-3642. If you choose to file a Request for Review with the PAC, you must do so within 60 calendar days after the date of the denial letter. 5 ILCS 140/9.5(a). Please note that you must include a copy of your original request for documents and the denial letter when filing a Request for Review with the PAC. You also have the right to seek judicial review of your denial by filing a lawsuit in the State circuit court. 5 ILCS 140/11.
