Both of these surveys took place in the first half of 2025. Key results in these surveys included hiring a Superintendent with experience and that would provide increased communication. The Principal survey called for a leader with high energy and an excellent communicator. Foley Public Schools has not completed a staff, student, and family survey to survey satisfaction with the District in recent years.
