The current concentration areas remain the same: Athletic Training – Non Teaching; Athletic Training – Teaching (EC-12); Human Performance – Teaching (EC-12); and Recreation and Leisure – Non Teaching.

Approval is requested to change the name of the degree from M.S. in Health and Human Performance to M.S. in Kinesiology with a concentration in Health and Human Performance.
