Food Service

Food Service Background

- Food Service is a revenue neutral operation
 - No M&O funds are expended
 - Self Funding for capital
 - Revenue can only be spent on Food Service functions
- 20 serving sites
 - 147 employees
- 1,906,386 meals served in school year 2016
 - 10,710 meals per day
 - 788,359 breakfast
 - 1,118,027 lunch







Food Service Background

- \$5,460,338 in gross revenue
 - \$4,165,003 ADE reimbursement
 - \$1,295,335 sales
- \$5,024,631 in expenses
 - \$1,950,962 in labor
 - \$2,724,001 in food
 - \$214,167 maintenance and services
 - \$131,516 equipment
 - \$3,985 permits, fees, other expenses
- \$435,707 net revenue (up from -70,136 in SY 2013/14)







Arizona Department of Education National School Lunch Program

- Plate time
 - Students should be provided with adequate time to eat
 - Generally defined as 20 min to eat
 - Exclude time in line
- Designated Meal Time
 - Lunch must be served between 10:00 and 2:00
 - Breakfast is optional
- Comply with Dietary Guidelines for Americans
 - Fruits and Vegetables daily (salad bars)
 - Whole grains
 - Fat-free/low fat dairy
 - Lean Proteins
 - Very limited fat, added sugars, sodium







Breakfast - Two programs

- Standard breakfast
 - Student eat in cafeteria
 - Bus arrives 20 30 min before bell to provide opportunity
 - Students served only if they choose
- Breakfast in the Classroom
 - Students eat in the classroom
 - Bus arrives 10 15 min before bell
 - All Students served breakfast
 - Business decision





Lunch

- Need 30 minutes per 332 students is District average
- Capacities
 - High School 550 / per 30 min
 - Middle Schools 350 / per 30 min
 - Elementary 250 /per 30 min
- Number of lunch periods = Enrollment
 Capacity
- Teachers entitled to a 30 minute uninterrupted lunch break
