Purpose of Report

This item is a one-year update of a three-year formal partnership between Denton ISD and The University of North Texas, to apply Design Thinking concepts across the curriculum in Fine Arts. This partnership engages faculty from the College of Visual Arts & Design, and faculty in Fine Arts in curriculum-development and delivery, creating connective tissue between Denton ISD and The University of North Texas. This effort is intended to contribute to creation of a culture ripe for integrated instruction, fostering inquiry across the curriculum.

<u>Objectives</u>

- Development of a vertically and horizontally aligned Secondary Art Curriculum grounded in Design Thinking, formatted in UbD, focused in College/Career Readiness.
- This action creates a bridge between a Tier One Research University, and a public K-12 school district by forming a Professional Learning Community involving faculty from both entities.

Operational Impact

Denton ISD Fine Arts Costs: \$4400 in Ed Leave \$2100 in summer pay \$300 in consulting fee for elementary expert Total: \$6800

May 2018: Professional Development to train Art. Dance, and Theatre faculty teams in Design Thinking

August 2018: Applications accepted for Fine Arts Curriculum teams

September 2018: Teachers and Principals notified of Curriculum Team appointments

October 2018: PLC with Onstead Institute, UNT and Denton ISD Faculty begins

October 26, November 11, January 18, February 22, April 26: Denton ISD Curriculum and Instruction Science Coordinator Brianna Morris trains Denton ISD Curriculum team and UNT Faculty participants in Understanding by Design Curriculum writing.

January 7 and March 18, 2019: Denton ISD Art Faculty/UNT Faculty Professional Learning Community collaboration meetings (Scope and Sequence development).

April 2019: Two Week Co-Teaching Residency pilot in Art classrooms at Crownover MS, Strickland MS, and Rodriguez MS.

May 10, 2019: Research Proposal for Partnership Approved by Denton ISD Area Superintendent Research Review Committee
