

ORDER AMENDING AN ORDER CALLING A BOND ELECTION

THE STATE OF TEXAS :  
COUNTY OF DALLAS :  
COPPELL INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT :

WHEREAS, this Board of Trustees of said District adopted an Order Calling a Bond Election on February 25, 2013 (the "Original Order"); and

WHEREAS, it is deemed appropriate to amend said Original Order to reflect accurately the polling places and voting times established by the Dallas County Election Division; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby officially found and determined that said meeting was open to the public, and public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given, all as required by the Government Code, Chapter 551.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF COPPELL INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT:

1. The Board of Trustees of the District hereby incorporates the recitals set forth in the preamble hereto as if set forth in full at this place and further finds and determines that said recitals are true and correct.
2. The Original Order is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

WHEREAS, this Board of Trustees deems it advisable to call the election hereinafter ordered; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby officially found and determined that said meeting was open to the public, and public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given, all as required by the Government Code, Chapter 551.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF COPPELL INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT:

1. That an election shall be held between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 7:00 P.M. on May 11, 2013, in said District at the following polling places designated by the Dallas County Election Division:

2. That, as determined by the Dallas County Election Division, the Presiding Judges shall appoint not less than two nor more than five qualified election clerks to serve and assist in conducting said election; providing that if the Presiding Judge actually serves as expected, the Alternate Presiding Judge shall be one of such clerks.

3. That early voting shall be conducted by personal appearance at the locations set forth below and during the period early voting is required or permitted by law, being April 29, 2013 through May 7, 2013, early voting shall be conducted on the following dates and times:

4. That an early ballot board is hereby created to process early voting results, and the individual designated by the Dallas County Election Division is hereby appointed the presiding judge of said board. The presiding judge shall appoint at least two other members of the board.

5. That all resident, qualified electors of said District shall be entitled to vote at said election.

6. That a substantial copy of this Order shall serve as proper Notice of said election, and the President of the Board of Trustees shall cause said Notice to be published one time, not earlier than the 30th day or later than the 10th day prior to the date set for the election, in a newspaper published in said District or, if none is published in said District, in a newspaper of general circulation in said District. In addition, not later than the 21st day prior to the date set for the election, the President of the Board of Trustees shall cause said Notice to be posted on the bulletin board used for posting notices of meetings of the Board of Trustees.

7. That at said election the following PROPOSITION shall be submitted in accordance with law:

#### PROPOSITION

Shall the Board of Trustees of Coppell Independent School District be authorized to issue the bonds of the District, in one or more series, in the aggregate principal amount of \$79,500,000 for the purpose of the construction, acquisition and equipment of school buildings in the District, including the purchase of new school buses, and the purchase of the necessary sites for school buildings, with said bonds to mature, bear interest, and be issued and sold in accordance with law at the time of issuance; and shall the Board of Trustees be authorized to levy and pledge, and cause to be assessed and collected, annual ad valorem taxes, on all taxable property in the District, sufficient, without limit as to rate or amount, to pay the principal of and interest

on said bonds, and the costs of any credit agreements executed in connection with the bonds?

8. That the official ballots for said election shall be prepared in accordance with the Texas Election Code so as to permit the electors to vote "FOR" or "AGAINST" the aforesaid PROPOSITION with the ballots to contain such provisions, markings and language as required by law, and with such PROPOSITION to be expressed substantially as follows:

THE ISSUANCE OF \$79,500,000 OF COPPELL INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT BONDS FOR CONSTRUCTION, ACQUISITION AND EQUIPMENT OF SCHOOL BUILDINGS IN THE DISTRICT, INCLUDING THE PURCHASE OF NEW SCHOOL BUSES, AND THE PURCHASE OF THE NECESSARY SITES FOR SCHOOL BUILDINGS AND LEVYING THE TAX IN PAYMENT THEREOF, INCLUDING THE COSTS OF ANY CREDIT AGREEMENTS EXECUTED IN CONNECTION WITH THE BONDS

9. That in all respects said election shall be conducted in accordance with the Texas Election Code."

3. Except as amended by this Order, the Original Order shall remain in full force and effect.
