RECOMMENDATION:

Recommend approval of the attached Resolution setting the ad valorem tax rate for the Wharton County Junior College District at the rate of \$0.13684/\$100 for the 2020 tax year.

BACKGROUND/RATIONALE:

The college has received the certified tax rolls from Tylene Gamble (Wharton County) and Jordan Wise (Fort Bend County). Grace Utley, Wharton County Tax Assessor-Collector, has prepared the 2020 Tax Rate Calculation Worksheet for the Wharton County Junior College District. The Notice of Meeting to Vote on Tax Rate was published in the El Campo Leader News and the Wharton Journal Spectator on Wednesday, September 9, 2020 and the East Bernard Express and the Fort Bend Herald on Thursday, September 10, 2020.

RESOLUTION

- Whereas, the Wharton County Junior College is an authorized taxing unit for property owned within the limits of the Wharton County Junior College District; and
- Whereas, the 2020 Certified Appraisal Rolls have been received from the Chief Appraisers as required by Sec. 26.01 of the Property Tax Code; and
- Whereas, the Notice of Meeting to Vote on Tax Rate was published on Wednesday, September 9, 2020 in the Wharton Journal Spectator and the El Campo Leader News, and on September 10, 2020 in the East Bernard Express and the Fort Bend Herald in the format prescribed by the State Comptroller;
- Therefore, be it ordered by the Board of Trustees of the Wharton County Junior College District that there be levied for the tax year 2020 on all property owned within the limits of the Wharton County Junior College District on the first day of the current year, January 1, 2020, except so much as may be exempt by the Constitution of the United States and the laws of the State of Texas, a property tax at the rate of \$0.13684 per \$100 valuation.
